

Easy-learning plumbing for career changers

MATURE career changers are being offered a new, flexible learning plumbing course.

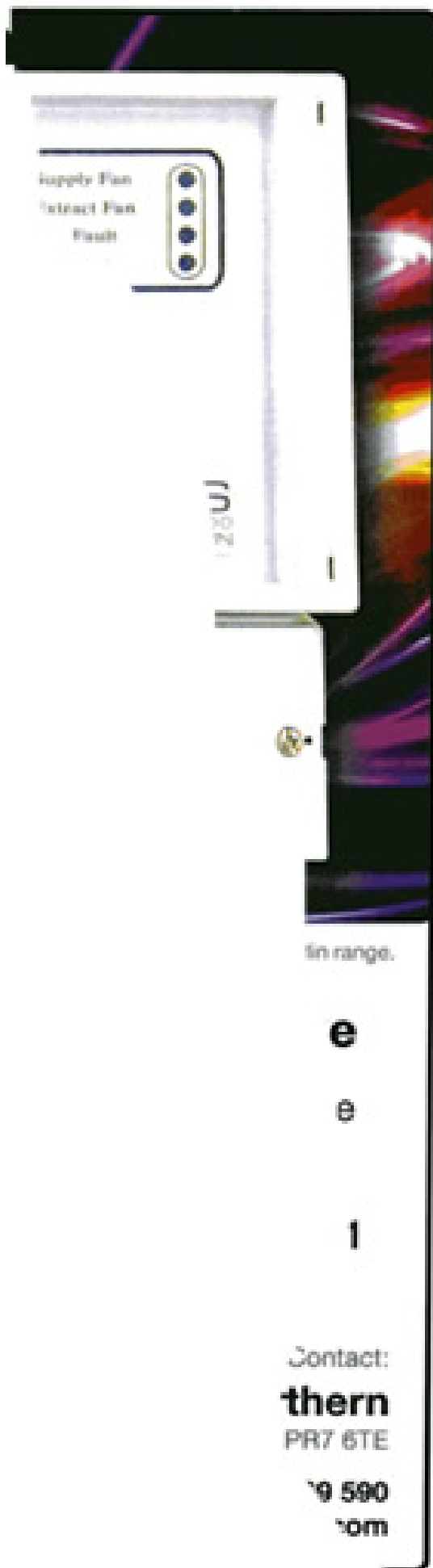
New Career Skills which provides training in plumbing, carpentry and electrics for mature students, seeks to address the skill shortage in the UK.

The course, which costs about £3,000, is the only one in the UK, says NCS.

The course is accredited by the Open College Network, the UK's foremost provider of accreditation services for adult learning.

With this course, the NCS offers a learning programme over a maximum of 18 months. This allows students to complete the theory training at home using interactive materials and tutor support. During this time, they also complete four separate one-week practical sessions at one of NCS' centres.

Once students have completed the course, NCS hopes they will go on to gain NVQ Level 2 and 3 but the knowledge gained should go some way to assuring potential employers the students have the best training.

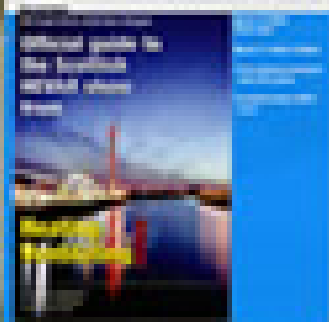

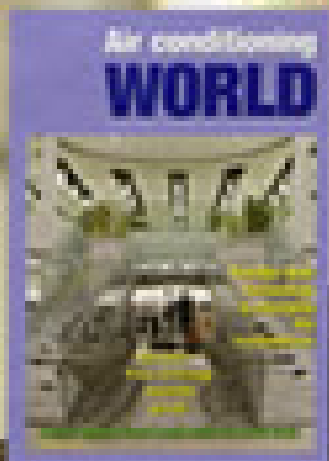
